#### 1st DAY

##### ARRIVAL BRUSSELS

Arrival at the airport of Brussels. Immediately after we leave for a panoramic introduction of the city (Grand Place, statue of "Manneken Pis", Atomium, Heysel stadium, Mini Europe (miniature models of major European monuments at a 1/12-scale), the Royal Palace of Laken and the Royal Church, the Japanese tower and the Chinese Pavilion, the stock market, the Grand Sablon square with the gothic church of Our Lady, National Conservatory, the Palace of Justice, the museum of Fine Arts, the Royal square with the Royal palaces, the European parliament and the Triumphal Arch). Afterwards transfer to the hotel.

In the evening rendez-vous at the reception of the hotel. Together with the guide we will go to the Grand Place on foot or by tram. Walk over the historical square and our guide will be happy to offer suggestions for dinner and drinks.



#### 2nd DAY

##### OPTIONAL EXCURSION LUXEMBURG

Rendez-vous at 08.45 at the reception of the hotel. We will pass the historical place of Waterloo. During the transfer to one of the smallest states of Europe, we will pass through the beautiful area of the Ardennes with its forests, small villages and magnificent castles. We will continue our drive next to the river Maas for a short while before we will stop for coffee at one of Belgiums nicests cities Namur. Continuing our drive to Luxemburg we will enjoy the scenery of southeast Belgium. After arriving at our destination we will drive through the city which for a part is build in and around a gorge. We will see the Palace of the Duke, the Cathedral, the impressive Red Bridge and the walls of the city of banks. Short stop at a mediaeval castle for pictures. (Cost: 65€ per person).

#### 3rd DAY

##### EXCURSION GHENT - BRUGES

Departure from the hotel at 08.45. First we will visit the mediaeval city of Bruges, one of the most beautiful cities of central Europe. Introduction to the sights of the city (park with the Lake of Love, the oldest hospital in Europe "Saint John", the Church of Our Lady, the much photographed bridge of Saint Boniface, the garden of Arends, the College of Europe, the first stock market in the world and the historical center, the jewel of Bruges.). Afterwards we leave for Ghent where we will visit the Saint Bavos Cathedral. Here we will see paintings of Rubens and Jheronimus Bosch and the wonderful polyptych from the brothers Van Eyck. We will pass the Castle of the Counts and we will get to know the city that was one of the major ports of Europe in the Middle Ages.



#### 4nd DAY

##### FREE DAY - DEPARTURE

In the morning check-out. You have many different options to fill in this free day. You can visit the botanical gardens or one of the many museums of Brussels. (like the museum of Fine Arts or the museum of Musical Instruments), galleries, many different kind of shops (like the ones in the area Louiza for example). Ofcourse there are also the numerous cafeterias, bars and restaurants. (Shops are open from 09.00 - 18.00).
